The AFO Course is for individuals responsible for operating clean, safe, and efficient aquatic facilities. The course offers in-depth instruction on:

- Filtration
- Disinfection, water testing, and treatment
- Design considerations
- Facility management
- Risk management
- Facility trouble-shooting
- Much more!

The Aquatic Facility Operator (AFO) program is a state-of-the-art five year certification for professionals managing and operating aquatic facilities. Individuals who obtain the AFO credential are knowledgeable in the systematic approach to pool operations including pool chemistry, management, pool safety and risk reduction. The 18-hour course features the AFO Manual, which is revised every three years to stay current with changing technology. The text is reader-friendly and enjoyable.

At the end of the course, students will receive 1.5 CEUs and a certificate of completion. Those who successfully pass the exam will become certified aquatic facility operators. Certification is valid for five years.
